

Life Groups Discussion Guide – 1 Peter 4:7-11 – “Saved to Serve”

As the discussion leader, there are several things to keep in mind for your Life Group.

- Pray that the Lord would prepare the hearts of your group members for the discussion prior to their arrival.
- Review your notes from the Sunday sermon and familiarize yourself with the discussion questions prior to your group meeting.
- Encourage your group members to open up. People will challenge and strengthen each other when they are truly open and conversation remains confidential.

Text:

⁷The end of all things is at hand; therefore be self-controlled and sober-minded for the sake of your prayers. ⁸Above all, keep loving one another earnestly, since love covers a multitude of sins. ⁹Show hospitality to one another without grumbling. ¹⁰As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace: ¹¹whoever speaks, as one who speaks oracles of God; whoever serves, as one who serves by the strength that God supplies—in order that in everything God may be glorified through Jesus Christ. To him belong glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen. (1 Peter 4:7-11, ESV)

Discussion Questions:

1. Which do you prefer: Beach vs. mountains? Cats vs. dogs? PC vs. Mac?
2. God gifts everyone in different ways, yet why do you think people do not use their gifts to their fullest potential?
3. Read verse 10. What gifts do you feel the Lord has given you to use?
4. How well do you feel you are doing as a steward of your gifts?
5. Share the areas in which you are involved in the church.
6. What could God do through you that you currently have not allowed Him to do?

Prayer Focus:

Pray that the Lord would reveal the gifts He has given to each group member and that they would use them to their fullest potential.
